- ✓ The Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) says that nearly 87% of Tennessee Memorial Day travelers plan to drive this weekend. AAA reports that 698,000 Tennesseans are expected to take a holiday road trip. That's a 4.1% from the 2021 holiday weekend. TDOT will suspend all construction-related lane closures on interstates and state routes beginning at noon on Friday, May 27 through 6 a.m. on Tuesday, May 31. This suspension of lane closures is designed to help motorists by providing the maximum roadway capacity possible throughout the state.
