U.S. stocks finished higher following the release of the Fed meeting minutes. Consumer discretionary and energy stocks outperformed. Oil prices were slightly higher at about \$110. The 10-year Treasury yield was lower at 2.74%. At the closing bell. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 191.66 to 32,120.28. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 37.25 to 3,978.73, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 170.29 to 11,434.74.
