TUESDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. equity markets opened lower and finished higher. The consumer discretionary sector was the only one lower. Energy stocks led the gains as oil settled at \$120, the highest level since March. International indexes were pressured. The 10-year Treasury yield was slightly lower. At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 264.36 to 33,180.14. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was 39.25 to 4,160.68, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was 113.86 to 12,175.23.

Free Fishing Day in Tennessee

◆ Anyone can fish for free without a license in Tennessee's public waters this Saturday, June 11th. The Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA) is providing the 2022 Free Fishing Day on June 11th in hopes of increasing interest in fishing. The day allows anyone the opportunity to enjoy a great outdoor sport to celebrate fishing as a wholesome and healthy recreational activity. Children ages 15 and younger may fish without a license beginning on Free Fishing Day, June 11th through Friday, June 17th. Several thousand pounds of fish are stocked annually by the TWRA. Free Fishing Day and Week apply to Tennessee's public waters, TWRA owned and operated lakes, and state park facilities. Some privately owned pay lakes and ponds continue to charge during this special day and week. Anglers will need to consult with those operators if there are any questions about a facility.
