

**FRIDAY'S MARKET REPORT** Equities headed into the long holiday weekend on an up note. The main focus remains on inflation and its impact on economic activity. The June ISM Manufacturing report revealed some encouraging improvement in supply-chain bottlenecks as well as prices paid. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 321.83 to 31,097.26. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 39.95 to 3,825.33. and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 99.11 to 11,127.84.
