### **August 4th Election Results**

The state primary and county general election was held yesterday. Many of the offices had candidates that were unopposed. The races that were contested include:

State Senate - J. Adam Lowe led with 53% of the vote over State Representative Mark Hall with 94% of precincts reporting as of fax time to be the likely Republican nominee.

McMinn Commission District 3 - Republicans Tim King and Roger Masingale defeated Democratic challengers Cody Hensley and Jean-Pierre Vasquez.

McMinn Commission District 4 - Republican Charles Slack and Independent Scott Cass won with incumbent Dale Holbrook exiting.

McMinn Commission District 5 - Republicans Travis Crisp and Scott Curtis won over Democrat James Cockrum.

Sheriff Joe Guy was re-elected over Independent challenger David Harper with 77% of the vote.

McMinn School Board District 3 - Republican Mike Cochran defeated Independent Colby Pilkey with 83% of the vote.

McMinn School Board District 5 - Republican Dustin Prichard defeated Independent Katie Brady with 75% of the vote.

Meigs County Mayor - Democrat Edgar Jewell, Jr. defeated current Republican Mayor Bill James with 54% of the vote.

Meigs County Commission District 2 - Andrew Howard won the 3- way race with 41% of the vote.

Meigs County Commission District 3 - Chris Finnell won the 5way race with a 7 vote margin or 27% of the vote.

At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 85.68 to 32,728.62. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 3.23 to 4,151.94, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 52.42 to 12,720.58.
