Stocks moved higher. GDP revisions showed a smallerthan-expected downturn in the second quarter. European and Asian markets moved higher. U.S. 10-year bond yields were little changed. At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Average was up 322.55 to 33,291.78. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 58.35 to 4,199.12, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 207.74 to 12,639.26.
