

Two Die in Airplane Crash

The Federal Aviation Administration confirmed that a single engine Cessna 182 crashed Monday evening around 5:15 p.m. near US Highway 64 at the Bradley County - Polk County line. The FAA and the National Transportation Safety Board will investigate with the NTSB as the lead investigator. The FAA will double-check the registration of the aircraft and should make that information public today. Authorities on the scene confirmed that the two people on board the Cessna died. The plane crashed in a heavily wooded area. Neither the FAA or the NTSB will release the names of the victims. That will be done by local law enforcement.

Equity markets started the day higher but the gains turned into losses after Russia announced that its pipeline to Europe can't reopen as planned. Energy and materials were the only sectors to finish higher. Government bond yields pulled back, with the 2-year yield declining. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 337.98 to 31,318.44. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 42.59 to 3,924.26, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 154.26 to 11,630.86.
