Senator Crews Swearing In

Joined by his wife Freda and family, State Senator David Crews of Athens, took the oath of office last Wednesday in the Senate Chambers. Administering the oath was Court of Appeals Judge W. Neal McBrayer.



Crews was appointed by the McMinn County Commission to represent Senate District 9 for an interim period until November 8, when a new Senator is elected. The seat was left vacant in August when former State Senator Mike Bell retired early from the Senate to begin a new role with the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency. Crews is a former Chairman of the McMinn County Commission.

FRIDAY'S MARKET REPORT Market anxiety remained high. European stocks were sharply lower after weak eurozone data and a new economic plan from the U.K. added to inflation concerns. Energy stocks led the losses. Oil declined 5.5% and dropped below \$80 a barrel. At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 486.27 to 29,590.41. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 64.76 to 3,693.23, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 198.88 to 10,867.93.
