

♦ Genia Shell Chastain, age 88, of Athens, passed away Sunday, October  $16^{th}$  at Erlanger Hospital in Chattanooga. She was a native and lifelong resident of McMinn County and a well known pianist. A funeral service will be at 7 p.m. Wednesday, October  $19^{th}$  at Laycock-Hobbs Funeral Home with visitation from 5 to 7 p.m. prior to the service. Interment will be at 11 a.m. Thursday, October  $20^{th}$  at Cedar Grove Cemetery.

#### World and National News

◆ Dollar General Corp. faces \$1,680,216 in proposed penalties after inspections at four locations in Alabama, Florida and Georgia which is a portion of the more than \$9.6 million in total initial penalties the company has received since 2017. The U.S. Department of Labor's Occupational Safety and Health Administration conducted inspections in April 2022 in Mobile and Grove Hill, Alabama; Tampa, Florida; and Dewy Rose, Georgia. Inspectors cited the retailer for four willful and 10 repeat violations for failing to keep receiving and storage areas clean and orderly, and stacking materials in an unsafe manner. OSHA citations also included those for exposing workers to fire and entrapment hazards by failing to keep exit routes and electrical panels clear and unobstructed. Finally, the company received citations for failing to mount and label fire extinguishers, and having a locked exit door that required a key to open. Dollar General is based in Goodlettsville, Tennessee and has 15 business days to comply or contest the penalties.

◆ Russia has hit Ukraine with a wave of attacks, dive-bombing the capital, Kyiv, with what appear to be Iranian-made "kamikaze" drones. Ukrainian forces shot down 37 Russian drones and three cruise missiles Sunday night, the Ukrainian Defense Ministry said. Multiple blasts struck Kyiv on Monday morning and air raid sirens were sounding in the capital. Ukraine may receive additional support in the near future as several NATO allies have announced during their two-day NATO defense ministers meeting their support for Ukraine.
