



- ◆ A crash at Fort Indiantown Gap, Pennsylvania involving two military vehicles claimed the life of one soldier and injured three others. The crash happened during a routine supply mission between ranges at the Pennsylvania military training area over the weekend, officials said. Officials did not release details about the crash, but said that it remains under investigation.
