✓ Beginning Wednesday, November 9th and Monday, November 14th, there will be possible delays with one lane traffic on County Road 166 (Mine Road) and Highway 30 West for road work by the State Highway Department.

✓ The City of Athens Public Works Department announces the following street closures for Friday, November 18th from 4 to 8:30 p.m.: White Street from College to Bank Street; Madison Avenue from Church to Green Street; Washington Avenue from Church to Green Street; Hornsby Street from Church to Green Street; Jackson Street from College to Highway 30; Long Street from Washington Avenue to Highway 30. These streets will be closed for the 2022 Old Fashioned Downtown Christmas.

TUESDAY'S MARKET REPORT: Markets finished higher as investors await results from the midterm election and look to Thursday's CPI inflation release. European and Asian shares were stronger. The price of oil fell. Bond yields traded around the flatline. The 10-year Treasury around 4.2%. Equities were higher. Bitcoin was down over 12%. At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 333.83 to 33,160.83. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 21.31 to 3,828.11, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 51.68 to 10,616.20.

2022 Election Returns

◆ The City of Athens will have two new Council members after yesterday's election. Newcomers Larry Eaton was the top vote getter with 1,407 votes and Steven Sherlin was the third top vote getter with 1,087. Incumbent Dick Pelley won the second highest number of votes at 1,125. Two other incumbents, Athens Mayor Bo Perkinson and Mark Lockmiller were not re-elected. The Athens City School Board will have a new member, Emily Forrest. She was a write-in candidate and received 696 votes to G. David Brown's 295 write-in votes. Incumbents Johnny Coffman and Abigail Burke Carroll were re-elected to another term. In state wide races, Republican candidates coasted to easy victories including the newly drawn 5th U.S. House district race which was the only genuinely competitive state race. Republican Andy Ogles will now represent a portion of Nashville in the House of Representatives. It will be the first time since the Civil War reconstruction that Nashville will be represented by Republicans. Congressman Steve Cohen of Memphis will be the only Democrat in the Tennessee Congressional Delegation.
