Today in History

1783 - Jean Francois Pilatre de Rozier and the Marquis Francois Laurant d'Arlandes made the first flight in a balloon, thus becoming the first men to fly - period. The pair flew nearly six miles around Paris in 25 minutes reaching an altitude of around 300 feet. Ben Franklin was one of the spectators at the big event. The flight came less than six months after the first (unmanned) public balloon demonstration.

1789 - North Carolina became the 12th state to ratify the U.S. Constitution.

1922 - Rebecca L. Felton of Georgia was sworn in as the first woman to serve in the U.S. Senate.

1973 - President Richard Nixon's attorney, J. Fred Buzhardt, revealed the existence of an 18 1/2-minute gap in one of the White House tape recordings related to Watergate.

1995 - The Dow Jones industrial average closed above 5,000 for the first time.

FRIDAY'S MARKET The S&P 500 and the Dow finished higher, but the tech-heavy Nasdaq declined. There was a 2% decline in oil, with concerns about a global economic slowdown weighing on prices. WTI oil fell below \$80. At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Average was up 199.37 to 33,745.69. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 18.78 to 3,965.64, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 1.11 to 11,146.06.
