Fatal Wreck on Highway 411

A fatal wreck occurred last Sunday evening shortly after 6 p.m. at the intersection of Highway 411 @ Highway 163, The Bowater Road. 81year-old Michael Piacenza of Port Orange Florida was driving a Kia Soul eastbound on the Bowater Road and allegedly failed to stop at the stop sign on U.S. 411. His vehicle was struck in the driver's side door by a Toyota Camry driven by 60-year-old Bobbie Jackson of Benton. Piacenza died from his injuries. Two passengers in the Camry were injured: Lecia Satterfield, age 58 of Benton and 84-year-old Lecia Colley of Reliance. According to the THP preliminary report, no charges will be filed.

WEDNESDAY'S MARKET REDORT: Equity markets rallied as investors digested the Fed's meeting minutes. Yields fell and growth investments rose in advance of the Thanksgiving holiday. The most notable move across different asset classes was the 4.5% drop in oil prices. The EU discussed imposing a price cap on Russian oil between \$65 and \$70 a barrel which is above Russia's cost of production and higher than some members had hoped. With commodity prices down, the energy sector was the only one to post losses for the day. At the closing bell: DJIA 34,194.06 (+95.96); S&P 500 4,027.26 (+23.68); NASDAQ 11,285.32 (+110.91).
