Tuesday's Market Report

U.S. large-cap equity indexes finished slightly lower. Small-cap stocks rose ahead of Fed Chair Powell's scheduled speech sometime today. China stocks rallied on prospects that the country could move faster in loosening its COVID-19 restrictions. Commodities finished higher. Energy stocks outperformed, defensive sectors and technology finished lower and yields rose. At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 3.07 to 33,852.53. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 6.31 to 3,957.63, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 65.72 to 10,983.78.


