House and Barn Fire

Last Friday evening around 10:30, a barn which was closely located to a residence caught fire on Co Rd 561 in Englewood. It was discovered that part of the barn was an apartment in which the owner had just replaced the wood burning stove. The owner had been visiting next door, and upon returning she discovered the fire on the wall of the wood stove. She tried to extinguish the fire with water bottles, however, the fire quickly spread to the nearby residence outside wall and then spreading into the attic with it sustaining extensive water and smoke damage. No injuries were reported from either structure. Englewood, Etowah, Athens, and Niota Rural Fire, Athens City Fire, AMR, McMinn County Sheriff's Department and McMinn County Highway Department all responded with Englewood Rural Fire Chief Billy Roach and Etowah Rural Fire Chief Adam Hafley in command of the scene.
