Wreck Hwy 30 and Co Rd 527 Etowah

A 2003 Chrysler PT Cruiser and 2008 GMC Truck collided at the intersection of Hwy 30E and Co Rd 527, Etowah, Monday around noon. The driver of the Chrysler was entrapped which required extrication and then transported by AMR to Etowah City Fire Dept to be airlifted by LifeForce to UT Hospital in Knoxville. Etowah City Fire, Etowah and Englewood Rural Fire, and McMinn County Sheriff's Department responded along with Investigating THP Officer Whitney Stooksbury. Etowah City Fire Chief Adam Hafley was in command of the scene. The passenger of the Chrysler was also injured and transported to UT Hospital Knoxville by AMR.


