1877 - The world's first long-distance telephone call was made from Salem, Massachusetts, to Boston.

1974 - Nobel Prize-winning Russian author Alexander Solzhenitsyn was expelled from the Soviet Union.

1988 - The 15th Winter Olympics opened in Calgary, Alberta, Canada.

1946 - The United Nations was founded on this day.

1974 the UN designated February 13th as WORLD RADIO DAY to mark the signifigence of radio as the largest mass media outlet available to the world.

World and National News

- ◆ Another unidentified flying object was shot down by the U.S. Military above Michigan on Sunday. This is the fourth airborne object downed by American forces in just over a week.
- ◆ More survivors were pulled from the rubble on Sunday, nearly a week after one of the worst earthquakes to hit Turkey and Syria. The death toll in both countries rose above 33,000 and is expected to keep climbing. This was the deadliest quake in Turkey since 1939.

FRIDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. equities finished the week lower, pressured by higher bond yields. The growth segments of the market, including the big-cap tech stocks that have led the gains so far this year lagged the most. Russia announced it plans to cut its oil output by 500,000 barrels a day next month in retaliation for Western sanctions. The reduction is equivalent to about 5% of Russia's January output. Oil prices rose about 2%, around \$80. At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Average was up 169.39 to 33,869.27. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 8.69 to 4,090.46, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 71.46 to 11,718.12.
