1725 - The first known Indian scalping by white men happened on this day in the colony of New Hampshire.

1792 - President George Washington signed the Postal Service Act. Letters delivered up to 30 miles cost six cents to mail. For letters up to 150 miles, postage was 12 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cents.

1872 - Luther Crowell received a patent for a machine for manufacturing paper bags. The patent allowed for the bags to have two longitudinal inward folds.

1962 - Astronaut John Glenn became the first American to orbit the earth. He piloted his Friendship 7 capsule through three orbits of the earth.
