♦ Virginia "Jo" Moore Stansell, age 79, of Athens, passed away, Friday, February 17th at her residence. She was a lifelong resident of McMinn County. She taught school for 32 years at McMinn County Vocational School and worked in the office for 5 years at Calhoun High School. She and her late husband, Eddie Stansell, were co-owners of Superior Sporting Goods. A funeral service will be at 12:00 pm, Saturday, February 25th at Wildwood Baptist Church with visitation at the church from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. prior to the service. Interment will follow the service in McMinn Memory Gardens. Smith Funeral & Cremation Services of Athens is in charge of arrangements.

♦ TWO CHARGED WITH MURDER

In last Thursday's Morning Fax, we reported that Liu Gabriel Huerta was arrested on Wednesday following a shooting that took place on Tuesday afternoon at a residence on Hawkins Road in the Sweetwater area of Monroe County. A child, Alayna June Butts, age 2, who was reported as injured in the shooting has died. Two people have been charged with murder in connection with the shooting. A spokesperson for the Monroe County Sheriff's Office said Liu Huerta and Itzhui Huerta face first-degree murder charges in the death of two-year-old Alayna June Butts. They also face charges including attempted first-degree murder, aggravated assault, burglary and reckless endangerment. Liu Huerta appeared in court last Friday. His bond was set at \$2 million.
