U. S. stocks finished lower. The 10-year yield was up modestly but remained just below the 4% mark. Stocks are still up more than 3% in 2023 amid the prospects of the Fed eyeing an end to its rate-hike campaign this year. The energy, materials and industrial sectors out performed. At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 5.14 to 32,661.84. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 18.76 to 3,951.39 and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 76.06 to 11,379.48.

McMinn Incident Reports:

- ◆ Three juveniles are facing charges after Ryan Patrick Kelly of County Road 180, Decatur, reported that he had returned home about 9 pm Tuesday to discover a burglary and three juveniles he photographed. One pulled a pistol but yelled it wasn't real and they all ran away, he said. According to McMinn County Corporal Jeremy Harrison, deputy Michael Richmond found a juvenile boy and girl walking in a nearby driveway. The victim showed deputies that a garage door had been kicked open; two windows broken, a third glass broken in a cabinet, two vehicles that were extensively vandalized, and an impact drill and a Glock 19 Airsoft pistol were missing. While deputies were there, one juvenile returned with his stepfather and admitted what they had done. All three were accused of burglary, felony vandalism, and criminal trespassing. One was also accused of possession of a firearm during the commission of a felony.
- ♦ Monday, Barbara Edwards of County Road 350, Sweetwater, reported a twister tornado tore down a 1,700 sq. ft. barn and extensively damaging two vehicles inside. The damage was estimated to be about \$300,000.00.
