## Friday's Market Report

Markets were lower after the failure of Silicon Valley Bank, a primary lender to start-up companies and venture capital firms. SVB was not able to raise capital to boost its finances, causing regulators to take possession of the bank. As a result, stocks across sectors moved lower. The 2-year Treasury yield was down over 0.30%. The VIX volatility index moved up about 15%. The Dow Jones Average was down 345.22 to 31,909.64. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 56.73 to 3,861.59, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 199.47 to 11,138.89.

#### NCAA TOURNAMENT BRACKET

The Tennessee Volunteers earned a No. 4 seed in the NCAA Tournament for the fourth time in program history and will travel to Orlando, Florida to face 13<sup>th</sup> seed Louisiana in the East Region on Thursday at 9:40 p.m. ET on CBS.

The Tennessee Lady Vols were selected as a No. 4-seed in the NCAA Tournament and will face 13-seed St. Louis in the first round. Tennessee will host the first two rounds at Thompson-Boling Arena as one of the top 16 seeds of the tournament. A win would match them with No. 5 Iowa State or No. 12 Toledo in the second round on the following Monday. Virginia Tech is the top seed in Tennessee's region.
