House Fire in Etowah Claims 2 Lives

Authorities said Etowah City Fire Dept. requested mutual aid from Etowah Rural Fire and Englewood Rural Fire Departments for a structure fire on Louisiana Ave, Etowah just after midnight Monday morning. The structure was fully involved upon arrival of fire per-

sonnel. Sadly the two residents ofthe home perished in the fire. Assisting at the scene were Madisonville City Fire Dept, Etowah



City Police Dept, McMinn County Sheriff's Dept and EUB. Special thanks to Athens for standing by for the departments. TBI Arson and Bomb unit were called to investigate the fire. Etowah City Fire Captains Nathan Cole and Dustin Ruebush were in command of the scene.

WYXI RADIO and Morning Fax Reporter Wes Hall also says that parts of the structure collapsed and the interior was gutted. After a lengthy battle, firefighters were able to extinguish the fire and fire crews located two deceased occupants inside the dwelling. Etowah Police Department and the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation are also investigating. Authorities continued Monday

to determine the cause of the fire. The identities of the victims are being withheld until their family is notified. Nearby residents said that there was no utility service to the structure and that a neighbor had recently bought the occupants of the house a kerosene



heater which was found inside. It is not known if the kerosene heater was where the fire began.


