♦ At Tuesday night's City Council meeting, the council revealed the names of the candidates to be interviewed for the City Managers position. Deb Wallace will be interviewed by the City Council on Monday, March 27<sup>th</sup> and Corey Divel will be interviewed on Thursday, March 30<sup>th</sup>. Interviews will begin at 9 am each day. Once the City Council has concluded their interviews, the candidates will be given an opportunity to meet and speak with any citizens that are present.
