

Today in History

1783 - American author Washington Irving was born. His best-known works include two short stories: "Rip Van Winkle" and "The Legend of Sleepy Hollow."

1860 - The Pony Express postal service began with riders leaving St. Joseph, Missouri, and Sacramento, California, at the same time. The first crossing took ten and a half days. Riders stopped at relay stations every ten or 15 miles to change horses. The Pony Express became obsolete a year later when telegraph wires were stretched across the country.

1865 - Union forces occupied the Confederate capital of Richmond, Va. **1882** - Outlaw Jesse James was shot to death in St. Joseph, Missouri, by Robert Ford, a member of James' gang.


1936- Bruno Hauptmann was electrocuted in Trenton, New Jersey, for the kidnap-murder of Charles Lindbergh, Jr.

1948 - President Harry S Truman signed the Marshall Plan, designed to help European allies rebuild after World War II and resist communism. 1968 - Civil rights leader Martin Luther King Jr. delivered his "mountaintop" speech to a rally of striking sanitation workers in Memphis, Tennessee, less than 24 hours before he was assassinated.

1974 - Deadly tornadoes began hitting wide parts of the South and Midwest before jumping across the border into Canada; more than 300 fatalities resulted from what became known as the Super Outbreak.

1996 - Unabomber Theodore Kaczynski was arrested at his remote Montana cabin and an Air Force jetliner carrying Commerce Secretary Ron Brown and American business executives crashed in Croatia, killing all 35 people aboard.
