WEDNESDAY'S MARKET REPORT:

Stocks opened higher on Wednesday, after the latest read on inflation failed to produce any worrisome surprises, but the S&P 500 closed 0.4% lower while the Dow shed 38 points. Interest rates moved lower, with the 10-year Treasury yield falling back near 3.4%. Global equities finished higher as did oil and gold prices. The U.S. dollar was slightly weaker.

At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 38.29 to 33,646.50. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 16.99 to 4,091.95 and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 102.54 to 11,929.37.

Representative Fleischmann Introduces Bill

◆ U.S. Representative Chuck Fleischmann (TN-03) introduced H.R. 2491, the <u>Securing Aid for Every (SAFE) School Act</u>. The SAFE School Act establishes a \$900 million grant program that will allow public and private schools to train and hire veterans and former law enforcement officers to serve as school safety officers, hire off-duty law enforcement officers, and provide funding to harden schools and increase physical security. Congressman Fleischmann introduced H.R. 2491 as the companion bill in the House of Representatives to U.S. Senator Marsha Blackburn's S. 1107 in the Senate. "The shooting at the Covenant School in Nashville broke my heart and the hearts of every Tennessean and American. No child should ever be lost to gun violence, and no parent should ever lose a child to gun violence. We must protect our nation's schools and children from evil individuals who seek to cause senseless harm to others," said Rep. Fleischmann. My bill, which is the companion to Senator Blackburn's legislation, is commonsense and will provide funds for both public and private schools to hire and train former law enforcement professionals and veterans to be SROs and allow schools funds and the flexibility to increase security as they see fit. I sincerely hope that my colleagues in Congress and President Biden see the importance of this commonsense bill and quickly pass it into law, so we can keep our children safe.'
