MONDAY'S MARKET REPORT

Stocks were little changed. Small-caps outperformed. Earnings remain the area of focus. Sixty S&P 500 companies are scheduled to report this week: including Charles Schwab and State Street today; Bank of America, Goldman Sachs, Netflix and Tesla are scheduled later this week. Treasury yields were higher. At the closing bell, the Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 100.71 to 33,987.18. The S&P 500 was up 13.68 to 4,151.32, and The Nasdaq Composite was up 34.26 to 12,157.72.

✓ The City of Athens Parks and Recreation Department is offering an American Red Cross Lifeguarding course. This class teaches participants how to prevent, recognize, and respond to aquatic emergencies, and to provide care for breathing and cardiac emergencies, injuries, and sudden illnesses until emergency medical services (EMS) personnel take over. With successful completion of this course, participants will be certified with Lifeguarding, CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer, and First Aid for 2 years. Class times will be hands-on, with direct supervision from the instructor. Class dates and times will be May 11th & 12th from 5-9 pm, May 13th & 14th from 9-6 pm, and May 15th from 5-9 pm; participants must attend all classes. In the event of bad weather, the class will be rescheduled. The participants will be required to pass a pre-test on May 11th. Registration is \$225 for lifeguarding class, \$175 for recertification class and is open from now until May 10th. Call the City of Athens Parks and Recreation Department to register at (423)744-2704 or online. Participants must be at least fifteen (15) years old to register. Class size is limited to the first 10 registered.
