- ♦ THURSDAY'S MARKET REPORT: Equity markets fell. Tesla led the technology-heavy NASDAQ lower. Results showed contracting margins and falling profitability after a recent round of price cuts for its vehicles. Jobless claims came in higher than expected. Treasury yields fell. European equity markets were lower. Asian shares were mixed. The price of oil traded around \$77/barrel. At the closing bell the Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 110.39 to 33,786.62. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 24.73 to 4,129.79, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 97.67 to 12,059.56.
