## **Stabbing in McMinn County**

McMinn County Sheriff Joe Guy reports that the McMinn County Sheriff's Office is investigating a stabbing incident that occurred near Riceville. On Wednesday April 26th Sheriff's Deputies received a call of a female stabbed and lying in the roadway of County Road 725. Sheriff's Volunteer Public Service units arrived and provided life-saving assistance and were soon joined by deputies and detectives. "As the investigation got underway, the female victim was identified as Diamond Natasha Young 24, of Madisonville," said Sheriff Guy. "She was transported to a regional hospital for further treatment." "I want to note the quick response and life-saving actions of Barry Toomey and Chris Nunley, members of our volunteer Public Service Unit. They made a difference," added Sheriff Guy. "And they are to be commended." This investigation is active and ongoing. Detective Jared Price asks that anyone with any information regarding the incident to contact the McMinn County Sheriff's Office Detective Division at 423-745-5620. This is believed to be an isolated incident.

## **TWU Investiture**

Dr. Tyler Forrest (at podium) is now officially the 22nd President of Tennessee Wesleyan University. Dr. Forrest is the first native Athenian to head the University which was founded in 1857. Dr. Forrest shared in his comments to those in attendance that TWU now has strategies in place that will increase enrollment to 1,500 students; TWU will begin offering TWU Pledge, a last-dollar tuition scholarship that will allow HOPE Scholarship eligible students with a family adjusted gross income of \$36,000 or less to be able to attend TWU tuition free:

♦ THURSDAY'S MARKET REPORT: Earnings remain the focal point. The better-than-expected results from tech continues to support investor sentiment and key U.S. equity indexes. META earnings also exceeded consensus estimates, helping its shares rally by 14%. The U.S. GDP report shows slower economic growth, and lingering inflation pressures mean that the Fed is not in a position to pivot to rate cuts anytime soon.

At the closing bell the Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 524.29 to 33,826.16. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 79.36 to 4,135.35, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 287.89 to 12.142.24.
