FRIDAY'S MARKET REPORT The S&P 500 gained .8% closing the week higher by nearly .9%. First Republic Bank was down about 49% on the day. The company will likely require support from the government or larger banks to remain solvent.

At the closing bell, the Dow Jones Average was up 272.00 to 34,098.16. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 34.13 to 4,169.48, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 84.35 to 12,226.58.
