◆ THURSDAY'S MARKET REPORT: After a solid gain on Wednesday, stocks mounted a late-day rally to add to those gains. There were no official developments from Washington on the debt-ceiling front, but negotiations are ongoing. Interest rates were higher.

At the closing bell the Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 115.14 to 33,535.91. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 39.28 to 4,198.05, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 188.27 to 12,688.84.
