Cost of Stamps Going Up Again

If you still use the USPS to deliver your mail, you might want to visit the Post Office today or Saturday morning and stock up on the Forever stamps while they are still 63 cents each. Starting on Sunday, July 9th, the rate will be 66 cents each. The increases will raise First-Class Mail prices approximately 5.4 percent to offset the rise in inflation. The price for 1-ounce metered mail will increase to 63 cents, and the price to send a domestic postcard will increase to 51 cents. A 1-ounce letter mailed to another country would increase to \$1.50. There will be no change to the single-piece letter and flat additional-ounce price, which remains at 24 cents. The USPS says that two new package delivery options will be launched on Sunday They will be called Ground Advantage™ and USPS Ground Advantage Return Service. See USPS Ground Advantage[™] for information on the new services. The following services are being merged into the new services: First-Class Package Service®; USPS Retail Ground® service: Parcel Select Ground® service: First-Class Return® service and Ground Return Service.
