Sales Tax Holidays Begin Soon

Wo different sales tax holidays will help give Tennesseans a break in their bank accounts in the coming months. The first is the annual back-to-school sales tax holiday, held on the last weekend of July. This sales tax holiday sees clothing and school supplies, including some electronics like personal computers have no sales tax added to the total at the register, saving Tennesseans around 10% of their total costs for these necessary items. The holiday begins at 12:01 a.m. Friday, July 28, and ends at 11:59 p.m. Sunday, July 30.

After that sales tax holiday, Tennesseans will then be able to save money on food items when a three-month-long sales tax holiday kicks in. The new sales tax holiday was passed as part of the Tennessee Works Act, which was signed into law by Gov. Bill Lee earlier this year. The bill funded \$273 million for the one-time, three-month suspension of the sales tax on food and food ingredients. According to the Tennessee Department of Revenue, food and food ingredients are defined as "liquid, concentrated, solid, frozen, dried, or dehydrated substances that are sold to be ingested or chewed by humans and are consumed for their taste or nutritional value." Those items will have their sales tax waived from 12:01 a.m. Aug. 1 through 11:59 p.m. Oct. 31. Food and food ingredients do not include alcoholic beverages, tobacco, candy, or dietary supplements, according to the state.


