 \checkmark Grace and Mercy Ministries is having a Gospel Music Picnic Fundraiser Event on August 19th from 3-7 pm at the Athens Market Park Pavilion, 106 South Jackson Street, Athens. Enjoy music, food, and a live auction with John Forgety beginning at 6 p.m. They will be serving Hamburgers, Hotdogs, Chips, and drinks. Everyone please bring a lawn chair. Grace and Mercy began as an extension of McMinn United Methodist Ministries (MUMM) and now has its own Board of Directors. Grace and Mercy serves meals at Cooke Center to homeless and disadvantaged members of our community. Before the Covid pandemic, approximately 100 meals were served each Friday and Monday plus to-go meals only on Wednesdays. At this time, to-go meals have been discontinued on Wednesdays (except for those not physically able to come to the center for lunch). For many, this was their "church." This ministry is staffed by volunteers from churches and organizations within the community. Grace and Mercy also deliver 35 meals a week to people who are not physically able to come to the Center for lunch. At this time, Grace and Mercy serves lunch every Monday, Wednesday and Friday at noon. they serve 200 meals a week at the center (60 on Mondays and 60 on Wednesdays, 80 on Fridays). Grace and Mercy provides bus service to pick people up, serve lunch at the Center, and return them to their homes after lunch. The bus trip usually runs two hours prior and two hours following lunch.
