He continued his education and football career at Tennessee Wesleyan College and East Tennessee State University. He began coaching football at Science Hill High School in Johnson City, TN. He continued his career moving to the collegiate level coaching at Southwestern Louisiana in Lafayette and East Tennessee State University in Johnson City, TN. In 1968 Pete moved his family to Dalton, GA to begin a 46-year-long association with Josten's, Inc. Pete became a Christian at age 14 and developed a strong faith in his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. He was a longtime member of Fellowship Bible Church, serving on numerous committees through the years, as well as serving as a Deacon and Elder. Pete was active with the Fellowship of Christian Athletes for 60 years. He also served on the Board of Dalton Parks and Recreation. Visitation will be from 2-4 pm in the gymnasium at Fellowship Bible Church on Friday, September 1st. A Celebration of Life will follow at 4pm in the sanctuary.
