Community News You Can Use

✓ The Southeast Tennessee Human Resource Agency (SETHRA) will be distributing USDA commodities to eligible McMinn County residents on Thursday, September 28^{th} from 10 am-12 pm at the Athens Regional Park Expo Center, while supplies last. You do not need to be signed up the day of distribution but will be certified by providing proof of income for all household members or proof of category eligibility (SNAP, TANF, SSI or Utility Assistance or Residence in a Public Housing Authority) to get your commodity box. If you have already signed up for Commodities, the only item you will need will be your Commodities card issued by the SETHRA office. Eligibility will be based on total household income not in excess of the Stateestablished maximum percentage of the poverty line for the appropriate household size or category eligibility. In accordance with Federal law and USDA policy, SETHRA is prohibited from discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability.

Bruce also hiked the Chilkoot Pass, alone, from Dyea, Alaska into British Columbia, Canada. He once rode a motorcycle across the state of Alaska from Anchorage to the North Sea, something that would have been impossible not many years before. He also free-climbed Devils Tower in Wyoming. (Bruce Aulds Obituary continued) woodworker I've ever known," Three months before his 21st birthday, in the summer of 1979, Bruce bought a small amount of property in Gee Creek, and immediately began construction of what would become the Gee Creek Wilderness Lodge. He had never been involved in a construction project before. He built the cabin he lived in for decades; the framing, including the roof trusses, he made by hand; every stone on the cabin was carried to the site, and placed by his hands. Equity markets were flat. The S&P 500 was down over 1% for the week. Asian markets were lower. Yields little changed. At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Average was up 75.86 to 34,576.59. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 6.35 to 4,457.49, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 12.69 to 13,761.53.
