Tennessee Wesleyan University, in an effort to make college more affordable, announces the launch of the TWU Pledge. The TWU Pledge is a last dollar scholarship program beginning in the Fall 2024 semester that will allow incoming freshmen meeting certain criteria to attend Tennessee Wesleyan tuition free. TWU Pledge Continued

TWU Pledge will allow HOPE Scholarship eligible new freshman students with a family adjusted gross income of \$36,000 or less to attend Tennessee Wesleyan University tuition free beginning in Fall 2024. The launch of the TWU Pledge is the first step to improving student access and affordability for students across the great state of Tennessee. Tennessee Wesleyan consistently ranks high among many college and university ranking agencies, often with a cost of attendance well below other regional private and public universities. The TWU Pledge, for those meeting the criteria, will make Tennessee Wesleyan an even better option as students consider their post-secondary education objectives. The criteria are quite simple to be considered for the TWU Pledge.

- Student must be an incoming Freshman; transfer students do not qualify.
- Student must be a resident of Tennessee with at least a 3.0 GPA or 21 on the ACT.
- Household adjusted gross income must be \$36,000 or less (based on 2022 tax return)
