✓ The UT Extension McMinn (FCS) is offering a free "Hidden in Plain Sight" event on September 21st from 5:30pm to 7:00pm at Mt. View School, 145 Co. Rd 627 in Etowah. There will be a free simulation, led by Sheriff Joe Guy and SRO's. There's practice skills for identifying risky behaviors in youth environments.
