WRA To Give "First Fish Award"

There's nothing like seeing the smile on the face of a child when they catch their very first fish. Now, The Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA) will give your child a "First Fish Award" to commemorate that moment. So, the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency has a First Fish Certificate. You can go online, fill in the form, and send it to the TWRA and you will receive a copy of that certificate in the mail with the Chief of Fisheries signature. Or you can do it online and print it out yourself. It's a frameable certificate they can hang on their wall to remember that moment forever. When you fill out the form, just tell them the kind of fish, the date, and the location it was caught. The size of the fish and the age of the angler don't matter, only that the fish is their first, and that it was caught in Tennessee. However, the biggest jump occurred in its nursing program where TWU saw a 30% increase in the nationwide ranking compared to schools of all size and location.
