# RIDAY'S MARKET REPORT:

Stocks ended the day modestly lower. The S&P 500 was down about 4.8% for the month. The technology-heavy Nasdaq pulled back to 5.5% for the month. Bond yields held steady on Friday. The 10-year Treasury yield closed at 4.58%. At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Average was down 158.84 to 33,507.50. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 11.65 to 4,288.05, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 18.05 to 13,219.32.
