Skeletal Remains Identified

Skeletal remains found in McMinn County on October 19 have been identified as those of a Fort Oglethorpe man, missing from 2016. David Abbott was reported missing on June 23, 2016. His abandoned truck was recovered the next day in McMinn County, in a driveway on County Road 126 just off Highway 30, west of Athens. Abbott's partial skeletal remains were found by a group of hunters off Highway 30 west of Athens, in a wooded area near County Road 119, about 200 feet off the highway. McMinn County Sheriff Joe Guy said "The remains were sent to the Forensics Center in Knoxville last Thursday. On Monday we were contacted by retired Fort Oglethorpe Detective Steve Blevins about the possibility of the person being related to a case Detective Blevins had worked on in 2016. Detective Blevins contacted the Forensics Center about his cold case, and they were able to confirm the identification as David Abbott, of Fort Oglethorpe." Both McMinn County officers and Fort Oglethorpe Detective Blevins had searched the area in 2016, but Abbott was not found. Family members said Abbott suffered from mental health issues, as well as numerous other health prob-lems. Investigators say that there is no evidence of foul play, thinking Abbott walked off into the wooded area and passed away shortly after leaving his truck on County Road 126. His body was located about 3/4 mile from the location where his truck was found in 2016. This identification closes the case on Abbott, but Guy said his office and retired Detective Blevins will remain in contact with the family for resources they might need.
