## Grain System Safety & Rescue

Fire and Rescue personnel were instructed on how to remove victims from bin incidents. Between the years 1964-2005, 74% of entrapments ended in death; however with proper training classes between 2008-2011 the fatalities were reduced to 42 percent.
