•William C. Adams (Billy), age 96, passed away at his home in Athens on November 5th with his children at his side. He was born at home in Cedar Hill, TN on August 28, 1927. He graduated from Isaac Litton High School in Nashville, where he was a standout athlete and All-Nashville baseball pitcher. He graduated from Vanderbilt University in 1951. He served as an aviator in the U.S. Navy during the last months of World War II. He had a long and distinguished banking career in Tennessee, including serving as president of banks in Sweetwater, Maryville, and Niota. He served as president of the Tennessee Bankers Association and on the governing council of the American Bankers Association. In 1983, he was appointed by Governor Lamar Alexander as Tennessee Commissioner of Financial Institutions and had the unfortunate task of presiding over the largest bank failure in U.S. history (at the time) – United American Bank in Knoxville. He was respected and revered by co-workers and former employees, and by many for his numerous civic and charitable activities. A private family graveside service will be held at Spring Hill Funeral Home and Cemetery in Nashville. Smith Funeral & Cremation Services of Athens is in charge of local arrangements.

•Lydia Basic Wiseman Burke, age 75, passed away on Wednesday, November 8th at Etowah Health Care Center. She was born in Spietal, Austria and was a former resident of Cleveland, OH prior to moving to Athens in 1988. Lydia was a member of St. Mary Catholic Church and was retired from NHC in Athens. All applicants must reside within McMinn County, Tennessee, in order to qualify for assistance. The boxes will be packed and distributed at the National Guard Armory, located between Athens and Etowah off Highway 30. Boxes will be packaged on Tuesday, December 19, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. They will be distributed to members of eligible households at the same location on Wednesday, December 20, 2023, from 8:30 to 11:30 a.m. Online donations via credit/debit card or PayPal can be made online at friendlyfellows.org by clicking the donate button. Donations can also be mailed to P.O. Box 325, Athens, TN 37371-0325 or dropped off at The Daily Post-Athenian offices on Washington Avenue in Downtown Athens. Make checks payable to Friendly Fellow Club. Donations in honor or memory of a loved one are always a special tribute and are most welcome.
