# **Garden Club Serves Miracle Lake Training Center**

The center was founded in 1980 by Jack Bryan, who said the center has since changed the lives for over 2,500 men. "After four years of ministering to prisoners, I began seeing a pattern," Bryan said. "Men would be released from prison, and within a few months, they would be back in prison again. I saw the need for a center where serious-minded men could continue Christian train-ing upon their release from prison." The Etowah Friendly Garden Club serves Etowah and the surrounding areas. They're not only interested in the beautification of Etowah by growing healthy and beautiful plants and flowers, but also serving with programs that are of benefit to the entire community. 
