## Walmart Shoplifters Nabbed by MCSO







McMinn County Sheriff Joe Guy says some good police work by a McMinn Co deputy sheriff resulted in the arrest of 3 suspects found to be part of a Walmart shoplifting scheme. According to Sheriff Guy, around 9 pm on Monday night, Corporal Michael Richmond noticed a blue and gray Chevrolet pickup traveling down Hwy 30 west of Athens. The vehicle was using an off road only light, so Richmond was suspicious, and activated his blue lights. After a few moments, the vehicle eventually came to a stop. Richmond spoke with the driver of the vehicle, Jacob Jarnow, 21, of Athens, and the passengers Dottie Yearwood, 36, of Dayton, and Daniel Yearwood, 43, of Cleveland. Richmond also noticed that the back of the truck was full of brand-new retail items, several with security tags still attached. "When Cpl Richmond questioned the suspects about the items, they claimed they had been Christmas shopping," said Sheriff Guy. "But there were no shopping bags or receipts." Richmond discovered that Jarnow was driving on a revoked license and located drug paraphernalia in the vehicle. When Richmond patted down Jarnow during the arrest, he noticed that the man was wearing a Walmart vest under his coat, which caused Richmond to become even more suspicious. While speaking to all three suspects, it became evident that the items had been taken from Walmart, so Richmond asked for Athens Police to pay a visit to Walmart to confirm the theft. Athens Police spoke with Walmart management, who were already suspicious that shoplifting had occurred earlier. Athens Police and Walmart Loss Prevention began an investigation. After reviewing security cameras, it was discovered that Jarnow had entered the store, put on the employee vest, and then pretending to be an employee began to take items out of the store. "He took them right out the door," said Sheriff Guy. "He looked like he was just any employee taking some items outside." Dottie Yearwood had also shoplifted several of the items, all of which were estimated to be valued at \$1770. The items were returned to the store and all three suspects were charged in the theft. Jacob Jarnow was charged with Possession of Unlawful Drug Paraphernalia, Driving on a Revoked License, and Shoplifting. Dottie Yearwood was charged with Possession of Unlawful Drug Paraphernalia, Theft of Property, and Shoplifting and was released after making a \$2000 bond. Daniel Yearwood remains in custody on charges of Possession of Unlawful Drug Paraphernalia and a Fugitive from Justice warrant out of Georgia under a \$152,000 bond. Sheriff Guy says that Corporal Richmond was on duty as part of a Crime Suppression Unit, an effort of the Sheriff's Office to deter crime and drug trafficking. # **Georgia Mass Choir In Athens in February**

Renowned Gospel vocal ensemble, Georgia Mass Choir, performs under the direction of Reverend Milton Biggham in Athens on Sunday, February 18, at 5 pm. Georgia Mass Choir headlines this benefit concert for Gospel Jubilee, a Sunday morning radio show that airs on WYXI. The concert is free and, while no admission is charged, event organizers will accept donations as a love offering to celebrate the show's 54<sup>th</sup> anniversary. Gospel Jubilee has aired on WYXI every Sunday from 9am to 10am for more than fifty years. The show was founded be W. E. Burke in 1967 and is currently hosted by volunteers Stanley Blair, Karen King, and Jasmine Porter-McDermott. Proceeds from the benefit concert will go toward the expenses required to keep Gospel Jubilee on the air. Primarily, the event celebrates Gospel Jubilee's more than fifty years of heritage and provides our community access to world class gospel performances. This benefit concert is sponsored by Athens Area Council for the Arts (AACA) and McMinn County, Tennessee. The Douglass Family Gospel Singers begin the program. The headlining performance is by Georgia Mass Choir featuring the Rev. Dr. Milton Biggham. In his more than 40 years in the gospel music industry, Biggham has recorded, performed with, written for and/or produced some of the biggest names in gospel, including the Rev. James Cleveland, Albertina Walker, the Rev. Clay Evans, the Rev. Timothy Wright, LaShun Pace, The Mississippi Mass Choir, Dorothy Norwood, Inez Andrews, and others. Biggham is credited with the discovery of Kirk Franklin and Donnie McClurkin. Biggham produced Franklin's first hit, "Joy," with the Georgia Mass Choir and McClurkin's debut hit, "Speak To My Heart" with the New York Restoration Choir. As co-founder of the New Jersey Mass Choir, the Florida Mass Choir and the DFW Mass Choir, Biggham helped start a thriving choir music scene in the 1980s. In 1983, he founded the award-winning, 100-voice Georgia Mass Choir, with whom he scored a handful of Grammy nominations. In 1996, the Georgia Mass Choir was brought to the attention of Hollywood producer Penny Marshall, resulting in a featured role in the Touchstone film, "The Preacher's Wife," starring Denzel Washington and Whitney Houston, for which Biggham also served as gospel music director. For his work in traditional gospel, this Vietnam veteran who has more than 500 compositions to his credit, including "Prayer Will Fix It Every Time," "The Storm Is Over," "I Still Have A Praise Inside Of Me," "I'm Blessed," "Come On In The Room," and "I Owe You The Praise," has become one of the most sought-after producers on the gospel music scene. The concert will be held at International Light of Life Church, located at 1112 Congress Parkway North in Athens. She volunteered for Ducks Unlimited and helped at several banquets thru the year. The family will receive friends Friday from 4-7 pm at Englewood First Baptist Church in Englewood, with the service to follow at 7pm. Family and friends will meet Saturday at 12:45 pm at Highland Memorial Cemetery for a 1 pm interment. Weaver Funeral Home of Knoxville is in charge of arrangements.
