◆ The MCHS boys' varsity basketball coach, Randy Casey, has been removed from his position after sending what's described as an inappropriate photo to team members. McMinn County Director of Schools, Lee Parkison said, "For the good of our basketball program, we have made a change in the leadership for our boys varsity basketball team at McMinn County High School." Parkison's statement comes after a parent raised concern of coach Randy Casey sending an inappropriate photo. The parent says he was outraged that an inappropriate photo would be sent by a coach to high schoolers. He says the photo was sent last Wednesday evening. Parkison said that there's an appeal process and former Coach Randy Casey can offer an explanation. So far, a police report has not been filed. It has been reported that assistant basketball coach, Jay Johnson, will now fill the head coaching position at McMinn County High School.....(from Local 3 news)


