## Fire at HP Pelzer

Friday morning at 1 Athens Fire Department received the page for fire alarm at the HP PELZER plant on Industrial Way, Athens. Upon arrival of fire personnel, flames were visible and the plant was in production. At the point of arrival mutual aid was requested from Athens Rural Fire, Niota Rural Fire, Englewood Rural Fire, Cleveland City Fire, Bradley County Fire, Hillsview Rural Fire, and Riceville Rural Fire. The plant was heavily damaged by the fire. A trailer backed up to the dock was destroyed by fire. Assisting at the scene was McMinn Haz-Mat, AMR and AUB. 1799 -Former President George Washington was eulogized by
Col. Henry Lee as "first in war, first in peace and first in the
hearts of his countrymen."

1893 - Chinese leader Mao Zedong was born in Hunan province. 1947 - Heavy snow blanketed the Northeast, burying New York City under 26.4 inches of snow in 16 hours; the severe weather was blamed for some 80 deaths.

1980 - Iranian television footage was broadcast in the United States, showing a dozen of the American hostages sending mes-

sages to their families. 1985 - Ford Motor Company began selling its Taurus and Sable sedans and station wagons.

1994 - French commandos stormed a hijacked Air France jetliner on the ground in Marseille, killing four Algerian hijackers and freeing 170 hostages.

1996 - 6-year-old beauty queen JonBenet Ramsey was found beaten and strangled in the basement of her family's home in Boulder, Colorado. (To date, the slaying remains unsolved.)
2000 - Michael McDermott, an employee at an Internet firm in Wakefield, Massachusetts, shot and killed seven co-workers. (McDermott was later convicted of first-degree murder and sentenced to life in prison without parole.) Veteran stage and screen actor Jason Robards died in Bridgeport, Connecticut, at age 78.
2004 - More than 230,000 people, mostly in southern Asia, were killed by a 100-foot-high tsunami triggered by a 9.1-magnitude earthquake beneath the Indian Ocean.

### **Tennessee Unemployment Data**

As Tennessee employers prepared for the busy holiday season, new data from the Department of Labor and Workforce Development showed more Tennesseans were available to work in November 2023 when compared to the previous month. While the state's seasonally adjusted Labor Force Participation Rate remained steady at 59.4%, estimates show the number of Tennesseans not working increased by slightly more than 5,000 individuals. That change caused the unemployment rate to inch up to 3.5%, from 3.3% percent in October. In a year-to-year comparison, Tennessee's latest seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained unchanged and matched the November 2022 rate of 3.5%. Tennessee employers increased their payrolls by 19,500 nonfarm positions over the last year. The healthcare and social assistance sector saw the most year-toyear growth. The professional, scientific, and technical services sector added the next highest number of jobs and was followed by the local government sector. Between October and November, Tennessee experienced a decrease of 4,400 nonfarm jobs. The administrative, support, and waste services sector lost the most positions. The retail trade sector accounted for the next highest job loss, followed by the transportation, warehousing, and utilities sector. A complete analysis of Tennessee's November 2023 unemployment data is available <a href="here">here</a> The nation's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for November came in at 3.7%, 0.2 of a percentage point higher than Tennessee's rate for the month. The new national rate dropped 0.2 of a percentage point when compared to the previous month's rate of 3.9% but was up 0.1 of a percentage point from the 3.6% rate in November 2022. Tennesseans looking to start the new year with a new job can begin that search at one of nearly 80 American Job Centers across the state. Career specialists work one-on-one with job seekers to help them find employment, training for new career opportunities, and programs that can help remove any barriers that are keeping them from advancing in the workforce. All the services the state offers come at no cost to Tennesseans. This interactive map will guide job seekers to the American Job Center that is closest to them.
