\$10 Million Federal Lawsuit Filed

Nathan Alexander Smith, the son of Tabitha Marie Smith, who tragically drowned in the back seat of a Meigs County Sheriff's Office patrol car along with the deputy driving the vehicle, has filed a \$10 million federal lawsuit. The incident occurred on February 14 when Deputy Robert John "R.J." Leonard Jr. inadvertently drove the car into the Tennessee River. The lawsuit,



seeking nominal, punitive, compensatory, and presumed damages for Tabitha Smith's drowning death.

filed in U.S. District Court in Chattanooga. Defendants in the case include Meigs County government and Deputy Leonard. Tabitha Smith, a 35-year-old mother of four, originally from Chicago, had three minor siblings.



Fleischmann Commends New Bill

Chairman of Energy and Water Appropriations, U.S. Representative Chuck Fleischmann, praised the approval of the fiscal year 2024 Energy and Water Development appropriations bill. The bill is commended for its historic investments in enhancing and modernizing the U.S. nuclear stockpile, promoting the country's New Nuclear Future, and providing crucial support for basic science and energy security initiatives at the Oak Ridge National Lab (ORNL) and across the nation.

TWRA Seeking Angler Feedback

The Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA) is actively seeking feedback for the revision of its trout plan, specifically focusing on the management of the Hiwassee River Trout Fishery. To ensure the ongoing effectiveness and relevance of management strategies, the TWRA regularly updates the Hiwassee River Trout Fishery Management Plan. A recent in-person meeting at Lee University drew over 50 attendees, featuring presentations and Q&A sessions with staff from TVA, U.S. Forest Service, and Tellico Hatchery, providing a platform for comments and input.
