### **Proposed Tennessee Law Targets Pets**

A proposed law in Tennessee, initiated by restaurant owners in Savannah, is nearing approval. The bill aims to prohibit non-service animals from entering indoor areas of restaurants due to issues caused by customers bringing in pets. If passed, the law would still allow animals in outdoor areas. Notably, certified service animals would be exempt, as per federal regulations, while optional support animals, lacking service animal certification, would be impacted. Some restaurant owners have reported threats from customers upset about not being allowed to bring their non-service pets into establishments.
