### Etowah Man Found Guilty of Attempted Murder

Jan Louis Johnson, age 63 of Etowah, was found guilty of attempted first-degree murder for shooting his wife, whom he falsely believed was having an affair with a biker. The McMinn County Attorney General's office announced the conviction on March 13. Johnson was also convicted of employing a firearm during a dangerous offense. Prosecutors stated during the two-day trial that Johnson shot his wife twice in the stomach on July 24, 2022, while she was preparing for work. Johnson's wife asked why he shot her, to which he responded that it was because of her alleged infidelity. When she told him that his statement wasn't true, Johnson then called 911 to report the incident. His sentencing is scheduled for Friday, May 10.

### **State & Local News**

✓ Tennessee State University (TSU) in Nashville is undergoing leadership changes following the retirement announcement of President Glenda Glover. A measure in the Tennessee Senate proposes replacing the entire TSU Board of Trustees due to concerns about leadership and management, particularly highlighted by a scathing audit from the Tennessee Comptroller last year. Sen. Jon Lundberg emphasized the exceptional faculty and staff at TSU but cited issues with leadership. The measure passed the Senate Education Committee and now goes to the Tennessee House of Representatives for further consideration.

✓ A Tennessee man, identified as Charles Benson, was arrested by the White House, TN Police for shooting at homes in the middle of the night. One bullet nearly hit a 7-year-old girl, with 28 shell casings recovered from a neighbor's yard. Benson faces charges including reckless endangerment with a deadly weapon and public intoxication. Despite this, he was permitted to post bail with the condition that he abstains from alcohol.

✓ The Boys & Girls Clubs of the Ocoee Region (BGCOR) has opened a new Club in Etowah, serving around 55 kids daily. Initially operating from Etowah City School, they relocated to Etowah First

Baptist Church due to space constraints. Plans are underway to build a permanent facility near 6th Street in Etowah. BGCOR recently held its annual Youth of the Year event, where students present essays and speeches showcasing their personal



growth and club experiences. Elijah Pierce, from the Johnson Teen Center in Bradley County, emerged as this year's winner and plans to study film at Lee University. To support the Etowah Unit and invest in the community's youth, visit the provided link HERE


