
Longtime volunteer and former Board President Sheila Chesanow echoed the enthusiasm: "So

Etowah Splash Pad Closed After Soap Incident Damages System



The City of Etowah has temporarily closed its splash pad after an incident on Sunday, May 18, in which someone poured an entire bottle of dish soap into the water system.

City officials initially described the act as vandalism, though the intent behind it remains unclear.

While it may appear harmless on the surface, the addition of soap to the system can cause serious mechanical issues.

"This may seem minor, but it is not," the city stated. "It's very damaging to the pump system."
